Miss Rockbridge Fair Pageant Rules & Regulations

Please read the following: signing the application page acknowledges your agreement to these rules. The 2022 fair queens are also required to abide by these rules after receiving their title.

- 1. ALL contestants must physically reside in Rockbridge County, City of Lexington or City of Buena Vista; the use of family addresses for eligibility purposes when living outside the county/city will result in immediate disqualification or loss of title.
- 2. Contestants must be female, single, never married, without children, and never having been pregnant.
- 3. Contestant must possess strong moral character, have never been convicted of a crime, have any pending criminal charges, or have committed an act or engaged in an activity which is or could be characterized as dishonest, immoral, indecent or in bad taste. These regulations also apply to improper images/actions on all social media outlets.
- 4. All contestants must enter the division corresponding to their age as of pageant day. All winners are required to sit out one (1) year; they will be eligible to compete again in the 2024 pageant if they have reached the minimum age for the next age division (may not win the same title/age division twice).
- 5. Contestant line-up will be determined by the order applications are received by the fair (first in, last out).
- 6. The First Runner-Up in each age division must be willing to assume all duties in the event that the winner is unable or unwilling to fulfill her duties.
- 7. The 2023 titleholders are required to attend/participate/abide by the following:
 - a. The 2022 MRFP Titleholder Meeting immediately after the pageant on Saturday, May 6, 2023. The 2023 titleholder agreement will be signed, fair week activities will be discussed and general information about the year will be provided.
 - b. Various fair events during Fair Week (September 7-9, 2023) to include Princess Tea and awards ceremonies. c. Other events as requested by the Board of Directors, Pageant Committee and Pageant Directors. d. At least one (1) Christmas parade, but you may participate in all that we attend.
 - e. All appearances in Rockbridge County must be made with the fair crown/sash, but signs for other titles may be used in parades. All appearances outside of the county should be made with the fair title. All exceptions must be presented to directors in advance for approval.
 - f. The new Miss Rockbridge Fair must make all appearances with only her fair title.
 - g. Winners in each category will be asked to raise sponsorship money for their title's division for the following year's pageant.
- 8. All contestants and family/guests must always conduct themselves in a proper manner throughout the pageant. Any display of uncooperative or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disqualification of the contestant and removal of the individuals from the property. Incidents will also be directed to the fair pageant committee/fair board with the potential of the individual(s) being banned from the pageant as a contestant; this applies to incidents before/during/after the pageant, if related to the pageant. All rules, regulations, awards, schedules and information pertaining to the pageant are subject to change at the discretion of the Directors, the Fair Pageant Committee and the Board of Directors, if necessary.
